Pursuant to Circular No.23/2021/TT-BGDĐT dated on Aug 30, 2021, by the Ministry of Education and Training on the Admissions and education issued for master's degree;

Pursuant to Decision No.3685/QĐ-BGDĐT dated on December 31, 2025, on the Permission for VinUniversity to open Master of Nursing Science program;

Pursuant to Decision VUNI.74 dated on June 7, 2024, by Provost on the Admissions Regulations for Postgraduate Programs of VinUniversity;

We are pleased to announce that VinUniversity is now accepting applications for Master of Nursing Science Program, academic year 2026 – 2027, as follows:

I. TRAINING FORMAT, ORIENTATION, QUOTA

II. ADMISSIONS METHODS, PROGRAM DURATION, ORIENTATION AND MODE OF STUDY

1. Admissions methods: Admissions based on a combined evaluation of the application dossier and an interview.

The Admissions Committee evaluates applicants based on their academic background, research capacity (if any), English proficiency, study objectives, and research orientation.

Where necessary, applicants may be required to submit additional supporting documents or take subject-specific knowledge assessments.

2. Program duration: 24 months

3. Orientation: Research-oriented

4. Mode of study: Full-time

III. ELIGIBILITY AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Hold a bachelor's degree with at least a Good classification or have relevant scientific publications in the field of application.
- **Academic Qualification:** Have graduated from a bachelor's program in Nursing or Midwifery, or related disciplines.
- **English Language Requirement:** Candidates need to have English proficiency of Level 4 or higher (or equivalent according to the regulations of the Ministry of Education and Training) according to the 6-level Foreign Language Proficiency Framework for Vietnam.
- Having attributes that VinUniversity aims for (AACC): Outstanding Ability, Aspiration, Creativity, Commitment.
- Have a clear personal background and be in good health to undertake academic study.

IV. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS:

The application dossier includes the following documents:

- 1) Bachelor's degree certificate and academic transcript (translated into English);
- 2) Statement of Purpose (maximum 2 pages), addressing the following questions:
 - (1) Why does the applicant choose to pursue a Master's degree?
 - (2) Why does the applicant wish to apply to VinUniversity?
 - (3) The applicant's research experience and research interests;
 - (4) The applicant's future plans after completing the Master's program;
- 3) Curriculum Vitae (CV) in English;
- 4) Contact information of two referees (Professors or lecturers who have previously taught or supervised the applicant);
- 5) English language certificates or proof of English proficiency for programs delivered in English;
- 6) Evidence of scientific research achievements, research projects, and published papers (if any), including: certified copies of scientific research awards; official confirmation of the applicant's role as principal investigator or participant in research projects issued by competent authorities; copies of the journal cover page, table of contents, and full paper pages for published articles;
- 7) Certificate of recognition issued by the Department of Quality Management, Ministry of Education and Training, for Bachelor's degrees awarded by foreign higher education institutions.

VI. ADMISSION OPERATION

1. Admission timeline

- Application period:
Round 1: from January 15 to March 15, 2026
Round 2: from April 15 to May 31, 2026
- Application review and announcement of results: from June 2026 to August 2026
- Enrollment procedures: August 2026
- Program commencement: September 2026

2. Application submission

Applicants shall submit their application and upload all required documents to the portal:

Note: Applicants are responsible for the accuracy and completeness of all information and documents submitted to the system. The University will conduct a post-admission verification upon enrollment. If any discrepancies are found that affect the admission results, the application will be handled in accordance with the admissions regulations.

3. Application fee

2,000,000 VND/candidate (applies to candidates invited to the Interview round).

VII. TUITION FEES AND LIVING ALLOWANCE SUPPORT

1. Tuition fee: 932,400,000 VND/per year

Currently, the program offers a 100% tuition fee waiver for admitted students in accordance with the University's regulations.

2. Living allowance support: 15,000,000 – 20,000,000 VND/per month
